The Windows installer does not handle upgrades correctly. If upgrading the installer should:  <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Skip asking the user for an administrator username and password</li><li>2. Stop the service if it is running</li><li>3. Skip the --install call</li><li>4. Call --upgrade when done</li></ol>
