Currently attempting to switch to jDeb (away from using dpkg) in order to allow building of the packages on Windows and to be able to set permissions. Unfortunately, jDeb creates packages with the data files at absolute paths and these cannot be opened or installed.

Below are some solutions to consider:

1. Using a precreated tar data file
2. Using <data> instead of <fileset>
3. Changing jDeb to include an installDir (like it supports with Maven)
4. Using fileset instead of tarfileset
