I am on a windows box and I can export edit and reimport a csv fine. My co-worker is on a mac. If he exports and makes changes to this csv(via excel) and tries to upload it he is getting an extra return before the data in each row in the first column of the sheet. I have figured out why but don't know of a way to prevent it. His mac is putting a carriage return and a newline at the end of each row but my pc isn't.</p> |              |                        |            |
