Observations:

- Inputs endpoint is not accessible from SplunkWeb
- `_new` doesn't load either
- Endpoint is loadable from splunkd
- Listing endpoint with full namespace works

Questions:

- Is something to do with web.conf?
- Do other apps with web.conf work?
- Why does the listing work?
- Does this work on Linux?
 - Not on a production, upgraded host
 - Did work on a fresh install of 6.6
 - Attempting upgrade from 6.5.3 (install 6.5.3, install app, make input, upgrade Splunk install)
 - Still worked
- Can this be reproduced in another Windows install?
- Does this only exist when a build is upgraded?
- Does reinstalling the app fix it?
 - Trying: <https://build.lukemurphey.net/go/tab/build/detail/web-input-rome/14/installStage/1/install>
 - Nope
- Are there any related log messages?
 - Not that I can find
- Try loosening web.conf
 - <http://docs.splunk.com/Documentation/Splunk/6.6.0/Admin/Webconf#web.conf.spec>
 - Tried: works!
- Is this due to a combination of apps?
- Is there a way to get a list of all of the exposed endpoints?
- Can disable/enable inputs?
 - Returns 200, but doesn't seem to do anything

This works:

[expose:web_input]
methods = GET,POST,DELETE
pattern = data/inputs/web_input/**
```
