```
// Destroy model with specific key
var model = new MyModel({ _key: '5447fb752dbbb628d0224132' });
model.destroy()
  .done(function() {
    console.log('Model delete from server');
  });
```

I might want to replace the ajax call with something like this:

```
this.kvStoreModel = KVStore.Model.extend({
  collectionName: this.lookup,
  namespace: {
    'owner' : this.owner
  }
});

var model = new this.kvStoreModel({ _key: _key });
model.destroy()
  .done(function() {
    console.info('KV store entry removal completed for entry ' + _key);
    this.hideWarningMessage();
    this.updateTimeModified();
  })
);
```

2. Add the fail handlers for the delete routines.
3. Look for other instances of direct AJAX calls; replace them.
