    $("#dialog").dialog({
        bgiframe: true,
        resizable: false,
        height:140,
        modal: true,
        autoOpen: false,
        overlay: {
            backgroundColor: '#000',
            opacity: 0.5
        }
    });
});

function show_delete_dialog(url) {

    buttons = {
        'Delete this asset': function() {
            location=url;
        },
        Cancel: function() {
            $(this).dialog('close');
        }
    }

    $("#dialog").dialog('option', 'buttons', buttons);
    $("#dialog").dialog("open");
}
```

The onSubmit can be intercepted using a confirm() call. On the other hand, a jQuery dialog could be used that calls click on the relevant dialog button. Below is an example that clicks the "Delete" button:

```
$('#input[value=Delete][type=submit]').click();
```

```
