This works:

- section:"I John 1" work:new-testament ὀφθαλμοῖς
- section:"I John" work:new-testament ὀφθαλμοῖς
- section:"John 12" work:new-testament ὀφθαλμοῖς
- section:"John" work:new-testament ὀφθαλμοῖς

This doesn't:

section:"1 John 1" work:new-testament ὀφθαλμοῖς  
section:"1 John" work:new-testament ὀφθαλμοῖς
