For example, κατὰ in "De bello Judaico libri vii" 2.4.3 (<http://127.0.0.1:8080/work/de-bello-judaico-libri-vii/2/4/3>) does not find anything even though it is indeed defined (do a search in the admin for prepositions, [http://127.0.0.1:8080/admin/reader/worddescription/?q=down&part\\_of\\_speech\\_exact=5](http://127.0.0.1:8080/admin/reader/worddescription/?q=down&part_of_speech_exact=5)).
